2019 Annual Report to the Community

It was a banner year for technology training of residents, especially our older adults. Walk-ins and appointments for training were held. Small classes were also scheduled. As a priority these sessions improved digital literacy among our residents. We taught skills for use with email, social media, file management, and other apps and functions for computers and smart devices. Job seeking assistance including resume writing was very popular in these sessions.

Events & Visitors: Over 45,600 people were counted visiting the library. We held:

- 383 programs drawing 7,500 local participants
- 1539 adults met for 220 events
